## LORD'S SUPPER DEVOTION

1 Corinthians 11:23-26; "For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night He was betrayed, took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.' In the same way, after supper He took the cup, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of Me.' For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.'

The Corinthian church appeared to need a reminder of the true meaning of the Lord's Supper. They also needed to be reminded once more about the proper focus each one needed to have when partaking of the emblems. Paul gave them the reminders they needed. "At the Table" each week, let's pay attention to what we are doing and why we are doing it. Let our thoughts be on Jesus; and, may we proclaim as we should.

**1 Corinthians 16:2**; "On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made."

To the Christians at Corinth, Paul gave instructions about giving. He gave the details about when to do it. He gave them info about how much to give. What does God want us to do when it comes to giving? Maybe this verse of Scripture gives us good instructions as well – First Day of every week, in keeping with our income.
