Communion Meditation

Luke 10:38-42 (NIV)

"As Jesus and His disciples were on their way, He came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to Him. She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet listening to what He said. But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to Him and asked, 'Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!' 'Martha, Martha,' the Lord answered, 'you are worried and upset about many things. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken from her."

Martha got distracted. She let things take her attention away from the Lord. Mary stayed focused. She concentrated on spiritual things.

How about us? Do we let things distract us, or do we concentrate on spiritual things? The Lord' Day brings us an opportunity to be either distracted or focused, to put worldly things first or to give priority to spiritual things. Our Jesus calls for us to come to "His Table" and to remember what He has done for us. So, let us dine with Him and let us put worldly things on the back burner for a while.

Offering Devotion

Matthew 19:16-22 (NIV)

"Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, 'Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?' 'Why do you ask Me about what is good?' Jesus replied. 'There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments.' 'Which ones?' the man inquired. Jesus replied, 'Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother, and love your neighbor as yourself.' 'All these I have kept,' the young man said, 'What do I still lack?' Jesus answered, 'If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in Heaven. Then come, follow Me.' When the young man heard this, he went away sad, because he had great wealth."

What kept the rich young man from obtaining that for which he came to Jesus? It was the role that wealth played in his life. Jesus challenged him to put wealth aside and to serve Jesus completely. He could not do it.

As we contemplate our regular giving to the Lord we are presented with a challenge, a challenge given by our Lord to use our assets to advance His Kingdom. Let us respond to this challenge in such a way that we go on our way rejoicing, rather than go away sad like the rich young man.




AREA LADIES FELLOWSHIP
