## LORD'S SUPPER - DEVOTION

**Hebrews 10:10**; "...we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

Read those words again. Note what we have been made: "holy." Note how that was accomplished: "through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ." "At the Table" on the Lord's Day we gather together; and we do so with the understanding that we do not come in our own personal holiness, rather we come before Him in the holiness supplied to us by the sacrificial and atoning death of our Master. He has cleansed us from all unrighteousness; and He has adorned us with His righteousness, thus allowing us to have an intimate relationship with the Father. Let us take the time to reflect on this, to thank Him for what He has done, and to commit ourselves to continuing to pursue a life marked by holiness.

## **OFFERING - DEVOTION**

**2 Corinthians 9:7**; "Each man should give what he has decided in his hard to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

God wants us to decide what we will give. He instructs us that we should do so from the heart; that we should do so cheerfully. God wants us to truly know that He loves a cheerful giver.
