Communion Meditation

Isaiah 53:5

“But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed.”

This passage is about the Messiah, the Savior, about Jesus Christ. It was written many years before Calvary; it is prophecy, a prophecy fulfilled at Golgotha. It tells us that the One chosen by God would face death on the cross for our sins, our transgressions, our wrongs. It tells us that the Lamb’s wounds would bring us peace and healing.

On the Lord’s Day, “At His Table,” we meet our Savior and we reflect on the cost He paid for our redemption. And, it is here, “At His Table,” we sense His mercy, His love, His compassion; and we say to Him, “Thank You, Lord Jesus.”

Offering Devotion

Matthew 2:10-11 (NIV)

The Magi brought precious and expensive gifts and gave them to the newborn King. But the best gift they gave was when “they bowed down and worshiped Him.”

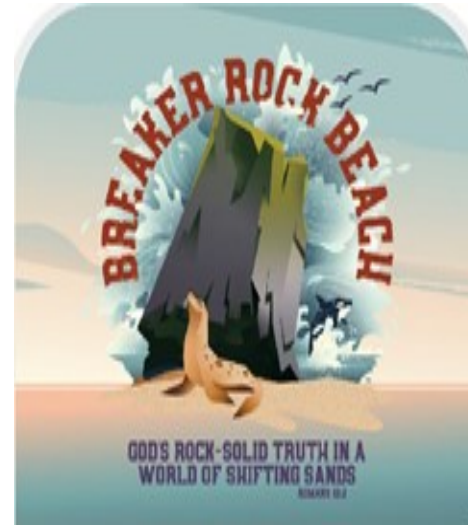
If He is truly adored and honored by us, then our giving will reflect our genuine and heartfelt worship of Him.
