Thoughts to ponder:

Alexandria is in Egypt. Ephesus is in Asia Minor. Why did Apollos travel so far? How do you think Apollos had acquired his thorough knowledge of the Old Testament Scriptures?

How do you think Apollos had been instructed in the way of the Lord? Apollos only knew the baptism of John, so he needed to know about baptism into Christ. Why do you think Aquila and Priscilla took the time to instruct him more adequately?

Is there a time for public teaching about Jesus? Why?

And, is there a time for private teaching about Jesus? Why?

How does it happen that someone can be sincere in teaching others about Jesus, yet not have all they need to know?

When someone gains new info about Jesus that affects their understanding of the Truth, what should they do?
