

QUICK LESSON FOR THOSE ON THE GO

(For this lesson, if possible, use the 1984 New International Version)

Lesson is from John 12:1-8

(v.1) Six days before what event? Jesus arrived where?

(v.1) Bethany was where who lived? What had Jesus done for this man?

(v.2) Why was a dinner being given? Who served? What was Lazarus doing?

(v.3) Mary took a pint of nard, an expensive perfume, and did what with it? How did she wipe His feet? The house was filled with what?

(v.4) Which one of the disciples objected? This disciple would later do what?

(v.5) Judas wanted to know why this perfume was not sold and the money given to whom? How much was the perfume thought to be worth?

(v.6) Did Judas say this because he really cared about the poor? But he said this because he was what?

(v.6) Judas was the keeper of what? Judas used to do what?

(v.7) Jesus told Judas to do what? Jesus said that it was intended that she save this perfume for what?

(v.8) You will always have who among you? You will not always have Whom?

Thoughts to ponder:

What should be your response when you do something for Jesus and people object to it?

How does the Lord know our true motivations? (Remember, He knew Judas' true motivation.)

Judas was a thief who stole money that belonged to the Lord. What are some of the ways we could be guilty of robbing the Lord?

Read again verse 8. What do you think Jesus means by these words?
