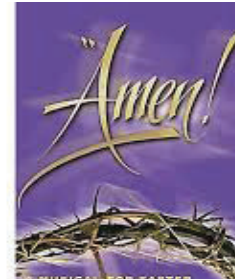

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 53:3a (NIV)

"He was despised and rejected by men...."
