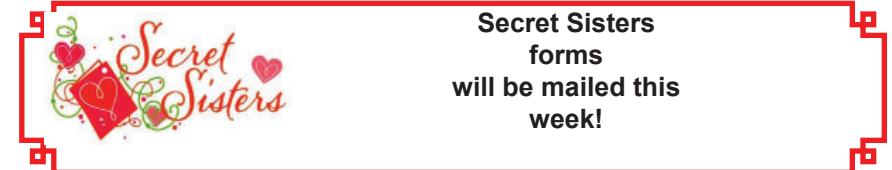

God loved us, and He gave. Oh, how He gave!

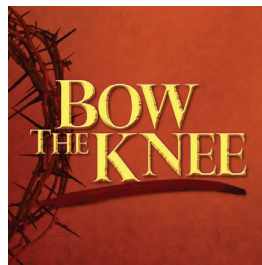
We love God, and so we give. And, may our Father be able to say about us, "Oh, how they gave!"
