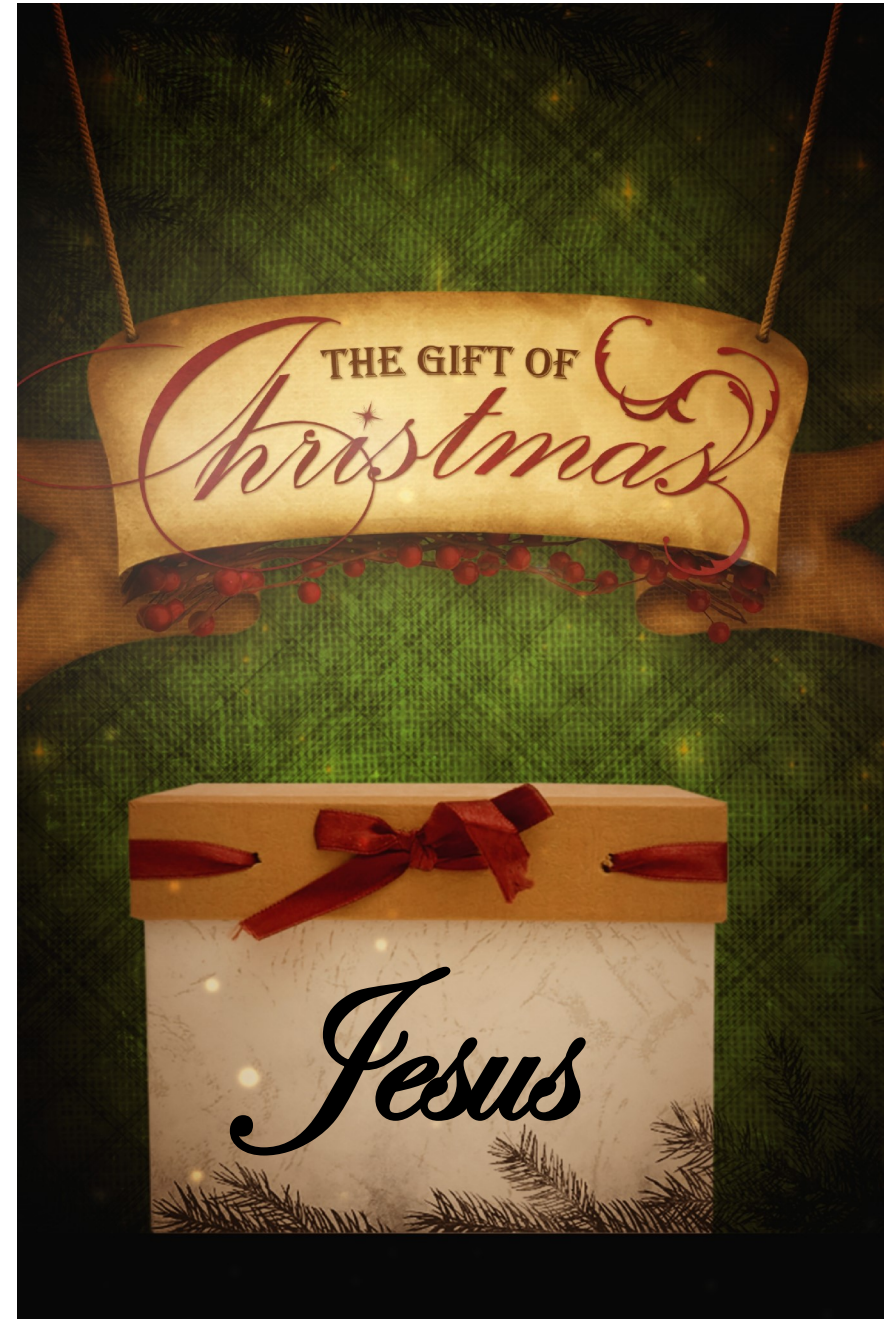
If you are homebound or in the hos-pital and you wish to be served the Lord's Supper, then please contact one of our elders. Thank you.

COMMUNION MEDITATION

Scripture Reading: Matthew 27:32 (NIV)

Jesus carried that cross as far as He could. The weight of the cross coupled with the devastating beating He had endured was almost more than He could bear. Not satisfied with His progress up the hill, the Romans forced a man from Cyrene, a man name Simon, to finish the effort.

Each Lord's Day we gather "At the Table." Here, we remember the sacrifice. It was cruel. It was horrific. But it was necessary. Because of what He did, we have hope. Because of what He endured; we have forgiveness. As demanding and as tough as it was, He went through it all for us. Let us take up our crosses daily, and let's follow Him.
