

A QUICK STUDY FOR THOSE ON THE GO

(For this lesson, if possible, use the 1984 New International Version)

Lesson is from Acts 9:36-43

(v.36) A disciple was in Joppa and she went by what name? How was the name translated?

(v.36) What 2 was she always known for doing?

(v.37) What happened to Tabitha/Dorcas? They did what to her body? Placed her body where?

(v.38) Who heard that Peter was in neighboring Lydda? Whom did they send to Peter? What did they say to Peter?

(v.39) Upon arrival, where was Peter taken? Who stood around Peter?

(v.39) The widows were doing what? What did they show Peter?

(v.40) Who did Peter send out of the room? What posture did Peter then take? He then did what?

(v.40) Turning toward the dead woman, Peter said what? What happened? Seeing Peter, she did what?

(v.41) How did Tabitha/Dorcas get to her feet? Peter presented her alive to what group?

(v.42) What happened when this became known all over Joppa?

(v.43) Peter stayed in Joppa for some time with whom? What was this man's occupation?

Thoughts to ponder:

The name Tabitha (in the Aramaic language) and Dorcas (in the Greek language) means "gazelle."

Describe Tabitha's/Dorcas' character; tell what led you to such a description?

What do you think was the reasoning behind the disciples sending for Peter?

What led many people in Joppa to believe in the Lord?

The Jewish people avoided all people who worked as tanners; what does that tell you about Peter staying with Simon who was a tanner? (Remember that Peter was a Jew.)

What does the resurrection of Tabitha/Dorcas reveal to you about the power of our Lord?
