- (v.3) Who loved Joseph more than any of his other sons? Why did he love Joseph more?
- (v.3) What did Israel make for his son Joseph?
- (v.4) <u>How did Joseph's brothers feel</u> about him when they saw that their father loved Joseph more than any of them?
- (v.4) What could the brothers not do?

Thoughts to ponder:

[Note: Jacob was also given (by the Lord) the name "Israel."]

What is jealousy?

Is there any jealousy shown in these verses? If so, by whom?

Should a father love one of his children more than any of the others? Why? Why not?

What is "tattle telling"? Is there a possible example of "tattle telling" in these verses?

Are there times when we should let a parent know when things are done by others that are wrong? What example can you give?

If we give a precious gift to just one of our children, how do you think the other children will feel?

Hate is a very strong emotion; how can we control ourselves when we feel ourselves having this type of emotion?
