Thoughts to ponder:

Why do you think Peter was traveling about the country?

Peter said to Aeneas that Jesus Christ heals him. Why do think Peter told this to Aeneas?

Aeneas had been unable to get out of bed for 8 years. Why do you think the writer of Acts shared this information in the telling of this account?

Would you describe the healing of this paralytic as a miracle?

Why do you think this healing was done?

What does the phrase “turned to the Lord” mean?
