(v.20) So the man gave names to each of what 3 groups?

(v.20) But for whom? No what could be found?

(v.21) The LORD God caused the man to do what?

(v.21) What did God take from the man? What did God do to the place?

(v.22) What did God make from the rib? God brought her to whom?

(v.23) The man said that she is now what two?

(v.23) She shall be called what? Why?

(v.24) For this reason a man will leave what two? Be united to whom? They will become what?
