

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

HERE ARE THE MAIN RULES FOR ALL STUDENT MINISTRY EVENTS & ACTIVITIES. FAMILIES ARE EXPECTED TO BE FAMILIAR WITH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN ANY EVENT OR ACTIVITY.

Conduct

- No alone time with members of the opposite sex...NONE
- Represent Christ with every action you exhibit
- Sponsors / Adult Volunteers are to be obeyed
- You are expected to participate in everything the group does
- You will follow all rules given (those stated here as well as those to an event's particular activity)
- Inappropriate conduct will result in a warning. Multiple warnings or one major offense will result in your being sent home or parents contacted immediately

Personal Electronics

- Cell phones, mp3 players, portable video game systems, cameras and video cameras: If used responsibly, are fine to bring.
 - o Follow guidelines as to when it is okay to use these devices. You will be told and expected to follow these guidelines

Dress Code

- When you pack, think about Jesus...this should help. Your goal is to represent Christ and MODESTLY present your body to the world
- Ladies, no low-cut shirts or tight/revealing clothes
- Guys, wear pants that fit. Bring a belt if necessary and wear it appropriately
- No offensive t-shirts
- Bathing suits: LADIES: Your option include: One-piece bathing suits, tan-kini that shows no midriff, a dark t-shirt/cover-up over a two-piece. GUYS: one that fits correctly.

Medicines and Consumable Substances

- Food: must remain in appropriate locations as determined for each event
- Medication must be used in full knowledge of a sponsor.
 - o Parents: It is your responsibility to make sure the sponsors/chaperons know if your youth is carrying any medications
- Tobacco: bring it / use it and you will go home
- Alcohol: bring it / use it and you will go home
- Illegal Substances: bring it / use it and go home as well as face criminal charges

Additional Inappropriate Items

- You may not possess any firearms or explosive (even small fireworks)
- You may not possess any fire-starting tools (lighters, matches, etc.)
- You may not possess any pranking items
- Don't push the limits...think before you pack, think before you act.
